

23 Pressman.


24 After considering the papers filed by the parties, the file in this action, and the
25 arguments of counsel, and good cause appearing, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

26 The hearing of plaintiff's motion to compel shall be scheduled in the Discovery

1 Department as soon as possible, and the hearing of defendant's demurrer and motion to strike shall
2 ^{continued} not be placed on the Law and Motion calendar until after the hearing of plaintiff's motion to compel
3 is concluded. Service of all motions has been completed.

4 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that section 425.16(g) of the Code of Civil
5 Procedure shall not prevent plaintiff's motion to compel from being heard in the Discovery
6 Department, nor shall section 425.16(g) prevent plaintiff from deposing Steven Pressman pursuant
7 to any order issued as a result of plaintiff's motion to compel.
