For the reasons expressed in the opinion filed herewith,

IT IS on this 26th day of August, 2019,

ORDERED that judgment is entered in favor of crossclaimant Interfor, Inc. (“Interfor”) in the amount of \$1,369,157.51 against crossclaim defendant NXIVM Corporation (“NXIVM”) on Interfor’s crossclaim for contractual indemnification; and it is further

ORDERED that Interfor shall file a supplemental submission on or before September 24, 2019, setting forth the attorneys’ fees and costs it seeks to recover for work completed by counsel from after May 31, 2017, and that submission shall also include a proposed calculation of prejudgment interest on all damages at a non-compounding 9% annual rate; and it is further

ORDERED that Interfor may not recover and shall not include any attorneys’ fees and costs it incurs in preparing the supplement submission; and it is further

ORDERED that NXIVM shall file opposition on or before October 15, 2019;
and it is further

ORDERED that there shall be no extensions to the above deadlines.
