Chapel, who also had that power. The power, and practice at the church, of both the Senior Elders and counsellors in regard to disfellowshipping not limited to individuals who were their counsellees, and prior approval by Barnett was not required in all cases. No prior approval by Barnett was required for placing an individual on special status. Disfellowshipping was usually automatic for violation of special status or refusal to accept a special status.

- 4. Attached hereto as Attachment B is a true and correct copy of the February 24, 1988 letter from the elders to Barnett regarding Barnett's special status.
- 5. Barnett met with the group of 16 elders for the last time on February 25, 1988. Barnett had requested the meeting and spoke at it for two to three hours. He placed the blame for his admitted misconduct on others. He was asked if he wanted more time to state his case, and said he did not.
- 6. Attached hereto as Attachment C is a true and correct copy of the Minutes of the Senior Elders meeting on February 26, 1988.
- 7. Barnett admitted at pages 15 16 of his November 26, 1990 deposition (Attachment D) that he was aware of his right to appeal from his disfellowshipping. He never requested an appeal.
- 8. At the February 28, 1988 service, there was no show of hands in support of Barnett remaining as pastor. My review of the transcript supports my independent recollection of this.
